The Board gave approval for Mike Henwood to collect more information regarding these banners and to prepare a proposal as to cost and installation. Toni Harper suggested that if these banners were installed the village might also utilize the brackets for holiday banners.

There was discussion regarding the Bremen Historical Figures. Most of the figures were displayed in December along Broad Street. The Board agreed that a formal plan of action was needed so the figures might be utilized in the best manner possible. It was suggested that the new park, located in the downtown area, would be the best possible location for the figures. President Mowry suggested a proposal be made to the Park Committee regarding locating the figures in the new park. It was suggested that Jonett Haberfield, Executive Director of Visit Fairfield County, be asked for input regarding this project. A formal proposal should be ready and presented at the July Board meeting.

The Board discussed the Community Service Fund and it was agreed that no further action was needed at this time.
